REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Fund Counsel Hourly Rate

The Executive Director distributed a letter from Jacobs, Burns, Orlove, Stanton & Hernandez, Fund Counsel, which proposes that their hourly rate remain at \$270, the same as the previous year.

Actuarial and Consulting Services Proposal

The Executive Director distributed a proposal from Segal Consulting, Fund Actuary, to provide actuarial and consulting services for the Fund through June 30, 2024. The Trustees reviewed the proposal and asked the Executive Director to secure a best and final offer from Segal Consulting.

Other

Chicago Park District PPRT - The Executive Director reported that the Fund received a supplemental contribution from the PPRT in the amount of \$3.1 million on October 22, 2019.

Illinois Department of Insurance – The Executive Director distributed a publication from the Illinois Department of Insurance which outlines the annual earnings, salary or wages maximum for the Fund's Tier II members for 2020, as well as the unadjusted change in the CPI-U over the last 12 months. He noted that this information has been forwarded to the appropriate Chicago Park District staff.

Upcoming events – The Executive Director noted that the Fund's current asset allocation will be reviewed with the Fund's investment consultant at the January Board meeting and that the 2020 Fund Operating Budget would be distributed to the Trustees for their review in advance of the December Board meeting.

Senate Hearing – The Executive Director reported that he and the Fund's Investment Consultant, Marquette Associates, attended a hearing and presented a report on the Fund's use of minority and female-owned investment managers and broker/dealers to the Illinois State Senate Special Committee on State and Pension Fund Investments on Wednesday, October 23rd. The Executive Director and the Trustees discussed the importance of continuing to support minority and female-owned investment managers, brokers and businesses.

Conferences – The Executive Director distributed a copy of the Board approved 2019 and 2020 Conference Schedules to the trustees and highlighted upcoming local conferences and events.

Mr. Michael Spychalski of Marquette Associates distributed the Preliminary Monthly Update report as of October 31, 2019, featuring investment performance, market environment analysis, asset allocation, rebalancing and individual investment manager performance as well as a memorandum regarding UBS TPF fee proposal Recommendation. The report and memorandum were reviewed in detail and the Investment Consultant responded to numerous questions raised by the Trustees.
